



Hello (Hola) to the people of St. Mary of the Lake (SML) and Our Lady of Lourdes (OLL)! I am delighted, blessed, and quite in awe how God has led me here to serve the good folks of this community as your Associate Pastor. SML and OLL hold a particular place in my heart. It was "just" 19 years ago (May 19, 2002 – Pentecost Sunday) that I offered my very first Mass at SML as a newly ordained ("baby") priest. Why did I choose SML for my first Mass? Before becoming a priest, I lived right over there... across the street on Buena and heard the daily toll of the bells of St. Mary's. AND it was at OLL's 24/7 Eucharistic Adoration Chapel that I received inspiration to continue my journey toward priesthood.

What a journey it has been, and I am sure it will continue to be, since 1995 when I began discerning my call to the priesthood while living here in Buena Park. Like any good marriage, my vocation has had twists and turns and challenges. But overall, my priesthood has been marked by enormous love and blessings from God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit with Mary, The Mother of God, guiding me...AND from the countless people I have served and have come to know and love in my various parish ministries.

My faith journey is somewhat like so many of your sons, daughters, grandsons, and granddaughters today (maybe even you) who were born and raised Catholic and then "fell away" from the faith. But God is a relentless lover who pursues His beloved souls no matter how far they wander from Him. God is so good – All the time! And **HIS MERCY ENDURES FOREVER!! [Dios es tan Bueno todo el tiempo! Y SU MISERICORDIA ES PARA SIEMPRE!!]**

Here is a bit about me now – I was born and raised in South Bend, IN. In 1984, I received a

Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering from Purdue University. In 1987, I moved to Chicago (Lincoln Park) and continued my career as an engineer. It was in 1995, during my time as an Environmental Engineer/Enforcement Officer with The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (Air & Radiation Division), and while I was active in a non-denominational Christian Church (I thank God for them bringing me back to Jesus!), that I began to sense the call to priesthood.

In 2002, I received my M.Div. and S.T.B. from the University of St. Mary of the Lake (Mundelein Seminary) and was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Chicago on May 18th (St. Pope John Paul II's Birthday!). Each parish assignment I have had has blessed, formed, and shaped my priesthood, while leaving an indelible mark on my heart. I have been an Associate Pastor of **St. Norbert** (Northbrook, IL.); Resident at **St. Finbar** (Burbank, CA.); Associate Pastor of **The Church of St. Mary** (Lake Forest, IL.); Associate Pastor of **St. Dorothy** (Glendora, CA.); Administrator of **St. Bruno** (Whittier, CA.); Administrator of **Christ the King** (Los Angeles, CA.); then some personal time to retreat, rest, and recharge in the Desert of Southern California, and now... as your Associate Pastor!

Why did I serve in LA? Since 1998, just before entering the major seminary, I sensed "a call within a call" to help bring a more dedicated pastoral presence of the Church within the entertainment community. The goal of this presence has been to help bring more truth, beauty, and goodness to the entertainment culture while attending to the spiritual needs of souls who work in that creative and challenging industry. During my seminary days, I went to LA during my seasonal breaks to work in the industry for a better understanding of how it works and the spiritual challenges people face.

I worked on commercials and even a TV Soap Opera called Sunset Beach. As a priest, I also became a chaplain for **Act One**, a Christian mentorship program in LA for writers, directors, and producers. In July 2012, Cardinal Francis George allowed me to serve full-time in LA and continue with the mission of ushering in a culture of truth, beauty, and goodness in entertainment. There is so much more to share with you on this ministry but for a later time. Now it's time for me to return to Chicago, keeping parish ministry (you) as a priority while lending a hand where I can with the entertainment mission.

My fellow Christians, I believe, under the gifted leadership of your pastor, Fr. Manny Dorantes, God has something wonderfully planned for SML/OLL. I am so grateful to Fr. Manny for welcoming me to be a part of this current history in the making for our community. I am so excited and looking forward to meeting you and reacquainting myself with the rich diversity and talents of this community that stands out so strong and beautiful on the Northside of Chicago like the artwork that adorns the churches of SML and OLL. I believe it is no accident that two parish communities, under the patronage of the Mother of God, are being brought together for a great purpose - Where there is growth, nurturing love, a humble and steadfast faith in Christ Jesus, and spiritual victory...there is Mary! May we strengthen each other in Mary's Fiat ("Thy Will Be Done") to what God has planned for each of us, individually and together. I look forward to this next part of my journey and I could not be more thrilled than to share it with you!

MY BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

I am Father Elvio Baldeón, I am 42 years old and I was born in Lima, Peru.

I began to discern the call to the priesthood when I was 17 years old. I entered the Major Seminary of Santo Toribio de Mogrovejo and studied Philosophy and Theology at the Faculty of Pontifical and Civil Theology of Lima between 1996 and 2001. When I finished my studies, I followed a different path from that of my classmates, I left the seminary and continued with the vocational discernment working in a parochial school as a counselor and religion teacher to high school students for three years.

After this wonderful time at the Santiago Apostol de Surco school in Lima, I decided to return to my formation for the priesthood. I received an acceptance letter to continue my studies in Chicago. After a year of preparation, I was admitted to the seminary of the archdiocese, St. Mary of the Lake in Mundelein.

After three intense years of learning and prayer, I was ordained a priest on May 22, 2010. During these more than ten years of priestly life I have served as Associate Pastor in the parishes of St Odilo in Berwyn and St James in Chicago. The most recent

community I served as a pastor for four years was Our Lady of Grace in Logan Square. I remember with great affection and gratitude the priests and parish

communities that have accompanied me throughout my priestly ministry. I ask for all of them in my prayers so that God will always grant them his grace to continue walking the path of the gospel.

I am very happy and honored to be a part of this community now Saint Mary of the Lake and Our Lady of Lourdes. With the help of God, I wish to work together with you in this new reality of Renewing the Church, putting at your service all that I have learned in these years of ministerial life.

For the time that I will be here with you, I ask the Lord to help me with his grace to give my best.




